Distance Learning

Overview of Instruction:

- Each day, scholars will access their coursework on the Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) during the first twenty minutes of the instructional period. (Log in instructions are provided on the school’s website).
- During the remainder of the one-hour period, scholars are to complete work using guidance and instruction from the VLE. Teachers will also be available for office hours to answer scholar questions pertaining to assigned work using Zoom. Scholars may submit their work through the VLE assignment platform.
 - Teachers will post links to their Zoom room on their VLE site.
- Scholars must complete and submit work by the end of the class period. This will count as their participation and work will be graded for completion and correctness.
- Teachers of each course will be available for office hours during the below scheduled times.
- Teachers of AP Course and College Courses can determine if they want to assign additional work outside for the hour period. Grades will be based on classwork and assessments.
